



## Drug Annual Report Presented

The analytical report on drug situation in Georgia was presented by the Southern Caucasus Anti Drug Programme on September 28, at the Court yard Marriot Hotel.

The report was prepared within a framework of the Southern Caucasus Anti Drug Programme, funded by EU and implemented by UNDP.

Representatives of EC, UNDP, Georgian Government, Patriarchy of Georgia, drug demand and supply reduction agencies and professional community attended the presentation.

The report highlights the key issues of current drug situation in the country, such as:

Dynamic of the process of elaboration of anti drug national strategy; debates within the professional community on the amendments proposed for the improving of drug legislation; spread of Subutex and injecting use among drug addicts; creation of the long waiting lists of the patients awaiting for treatment in the 5 existed clinics in the country; launching of the first Methadone substitution programme, etc.
